Notes:

1. The final men's qualification place (Europe 7th) will be offered to the winner of the EuroHockey Indoor Nations Trophy (Men) 2010. If Poland qualify as winners of the Trophy, then the second placed team in the Trophy will take the final qualification position.
2. If Poland (Women) finish in first place in the EuroHockey Indoor Nations Championships 2010, then the second placed team will take the Continental Champions qualifying position.
3. If Poland (Women) finish in the top 6 positions in the EuroHockey Indoor Nations Championships 2010, then the first placed team from the Trophy (Women) will take the final qualification place (Europe 6th).
4. If any continent does not take up their full quota, then the vacant place(s) will be allocated according to the final ranking positions from the 2007 Indoor World Cup.
